OVERDOSE DEATHS SOAR DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

More than 81,000 people died as a result of overdose in the US between May 2019 and May 2020 (67,367 in 2019). **That's the equivalent of the number of people who would die if there were 500 fatal Boeing 737 airline crashes.**

COVID-19 PANDEMIC INCREASED DRUG USE
