Jennifer Wysong fell into addiction after receiving an opioid prescription to manage pain after her C-section. Although her path to recovery was riddled with setbacks, she has celebrated 3+ years of sobriety and is now a peer support counselor at the same treatment facility that supported her journey to sobriety.



Jennifer Weiss-Burke lost her son, Cameron, to a heroin overdose when he was only 18 years old. Cameron's addiction began after he was prescribed opioids to treat pain from several sports-related injuries and surgeries in high school. Since losing Cameron, Jennifer began a mission to build something that she wishes would've existed for her son – a recovery center for adolescents battling addiction.
