
Core Circle

Circle of Engagement


- Hold leadership positions

Circles of Involvement




Circle of Champions

Circles of Involvement




Circle of Information & Awareness

- Provide resources

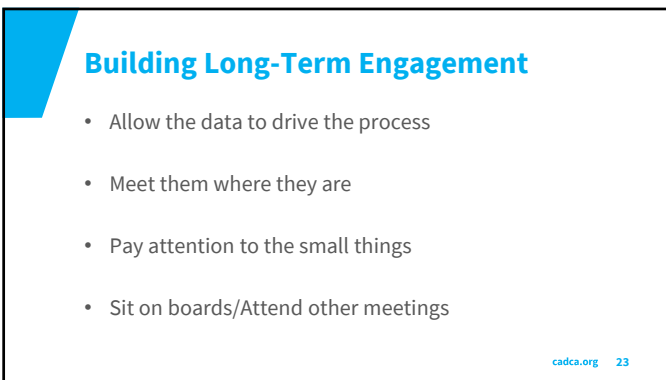

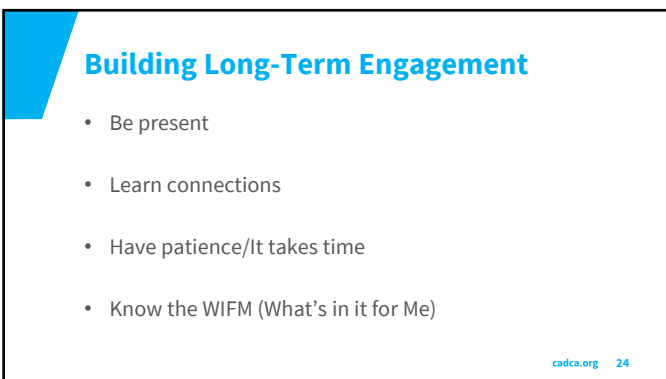
