- Identifying strengths and growth areas
- Supporting planning
- Increasing effectiveness and impact

▶ being integrated into CADCA's programs and initiatives

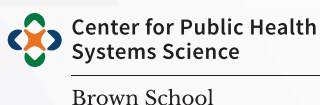
CADCA is committed to helping coalitions build their competencies. Coalition Competencies are already integrated with existing CADCA efforts such as:
